In honor of Financial Literacy Month, why not take the time to check your credit report, something the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection recommends that you do at least once a year? AnnualCreditReport.com is the only authorized source under federal law that provides free credit reports from the three major national credit reporting companies - Equifax, Experian, and TransUnion. Click on the above link to check it out.

If you would like more information, stop by the library and pick up a brochure about what mistakes to look for in your credit report as well as advice about what to do if you find a mistake. Or you may want the brochure on understanding your credit score. These and much more information are provided by the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection.
