Beyond weather, here at the library we are experiencing some of the same supply chain issues that everyone else is experiencing. Our book distributors have recommended that we order books early (as much as six months in advance) to help them have what we want in stock when we want it. As you can imagine, this is a bit complicated since we don't always know what books are being published more that a few months ahead. Plus it is difficult to know just when the books we order will arrive. So, it may appear that we are ordering tons of books some months and hardly any other months as books don't always arrive when we expect them. However, so far, books have mostly been coming quicker than I expected. This may change as we near the holidays. We will all probably have to exercise more patience than we may like.

I would also like to announce a new resource to which you now have access. It is an online graphic novel collection called ComicsPlus! Unlike some online resources, this one gives us unlimited use of their books. This means that multiple users can access the same resource simultaneously so there is never a need to wait for someone else to finish a book before you can read it. All books in the collection are available to you all the time! A link has been added to our website for creating an account. Please look further down in this email for more details.




## November Book Discussions
